

Important Public Notice

To: Pelican Bay Property Owners

RE: Pelican Bay MSTBU Balloting

Date: March 4, 2010

It has come to our attention that someone has made and distributed multiple copies of an original Pelican Bay MSTBU ballot to Pelican Bay residents for their use in the current MSTBU Advisory Board election.

By ordinance, each property owner in Pelican Bay is allotted one vote per property as defined by the Pelican Bay Property owners list that was provided to the Clerk of the Circuit Court by the Property Appraiser.

Any vote cast using a copy of someone else's ballot will not be counted AND it will negate that person's original vote, assuming they had already cast a ballot in the election. If you want your vote counted, you must use a ballot assigned to the specific property and obtained from the Clerk of Courts.

The Clerk's Office has also been asked if this act is in violation of the law and we are not in a position to answer that question. You must contact an enforcement agency.
