Notice to Clerk's Recording Customers

Dear Recording Customer,

Due to the difficult economic times and increased budget cuts, the Clerk's office can no longer afford the expense of paying for postage to return documents after they have been recorded in the Official Records. The current cost of that service has averaged around \$20,000 - \$30,000 per year.

Beginning on October 1, 2009, if you wish to have your documents returned after they have been recorded, you may choose one of the following three options:

1. Provide a self-addressed, pre-paid return envelope to the recording clerk
2. Request a "pick-up" box to be assigned to you, so you may pick up your recorded documents on a regular basis.
3. Provide sufficient additional funds for postage, envelopes and request the return of your documents.
