The Clerk's Office Introduces Interactive Online Forms*

TurboCourt, an interactive electronic forms program developed by Intresys, provides the citizens of Collier County with access to simple online legal forms that have been approved by the Florida Supreme Court. This do-it-yourself electronic forms service (for a fee) does not require a lawyer.

TurboCourt forms can be accessed via the world wide web at www.CollierClerk.com or www.TurboCourt.com/florida/ and filled out at your convenience and in the comfort of your own home, office or library.

The TurboCourt forms process has three steps:



Currently, TurboCourt forms are available in Collier County for **Family Law** matters including **Divorce**, **Small Claims** and **Tenant Evictions**. After locating the appropriate case area, a person is guided through an interactive online questionnaire, which provides explanations and answers to key questions while filling out the form. Once the questionnaire has been completed, TurboCourt automatically fills in the form based upon your answers.

Then, after paying a convenience fee to TurboCourt, the form can be printed out and filed with the appropriate office of the Clerk at the main Courthouse.

TurboCourt fees can be paid using Visa, MasterCard or PayPal.



***Please note: TurboCourt fees are separate from any filing fee required by the Clerk's Office.**
