Monday, October 6	Personal hygiene items (soaps, toothpaste, deodorant, tampons, etc.)
Tuesday, October 7	Plastic/disposable dinnerware/ tumblers; cooking and baking pans
Wednesday, October 8	Toilet tissue, paper towels, napkins, and facial tissue
Thursday, October 9	Laundry, cleaning and dish detergents
Friday, October 10	Used cell phones, towels, washcloths and bed linens (twin, fitted crib)
