

## **Press Release:**

### **Pay Traffic Tickets Online at New Wilson Boulevard Location**

Dwight E. Brock, Clerk of the Circuit Court, announced today that a new public kiosk designed to accept online payments for traffic citations using a debit or credit card, will be installed in the new Tax Collector's Office location at 50 Wilson Boulevard S.

The new location is intended to serve those who live and work in the Golden Gate Estates area and is in addition to the kiosks already in operation at the main courthouse and at the Clerk's Greentree and Golden Gate satellite offices. All of the computers used in the kiosks are recycled equipment.

The kiosks accept online payments using a debit or credit card for any (non-criminal) traffic citation issued in Collier County. There is a convenience fee of \$.50 paid to the Clerk's Office; and 2.95% convenience charge based on the fine amount (with a minimum charge of \$2.00) paid to Point and Pay, the online service provider.

The public can also check the status of their driver's license using the kiosk by clicking on a link to the Division of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles (DHSMV).

The new Wilson Boulevard Tax Collector's Office will offer a variety of services to the public including vehicle and boat title and registrations, hunting and fishing licenses, property tax payments, FL driver license renewals, original licenses (when road testing is not required), FL identification cards and select re-instatements. The office hours are Monday – Friday from 9:00 am - 6:00 pm.

Before paying a traffic citation, it is important that the public read and understand the three options available to them and then choose the one that is best for them because once an option is selected, you cannot change your mind.

The three options are written on the Traffic Citation Options form often provided to a driver by the officer at the time the ticket is issued. It is also printed on the ticket itself. Information explaining each option is available at each of the Clerk's Office locations and at CollierClerk.com, on the Traffic Department page.
