## Notice of Confidential Information Form

This note is being sent to you as a courtesy and reminder from the Office of Dwight E. Brock, Clerk of the Circuit Court of Collier County.

Starting on October 1, 2010 any court filings made in a Florida court that contain confidential information must be accompanied by a Notice of Confidential Information - a form that lists 19 specific items that should be confidential in court records, from Social Security and bank account numbers to juvenile delinquency records and grand jury records.

The Notice of Confidential Information is required by the Florida Supreme Court In Re: Amendments to the Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.420 and the [Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure.](#)
