Requests to be excused must be submitted in writing and RECEIVED AT LEAST **FIVE** DAYS PRIOR to the reporting date shown on the summonsform.

## Upon request, you will be excused for the reasons shown below.

- am 70 years of age or older and wish to be permanently excused.
- am 70 years of age or older and wish to be excused for this term only.
- am not a legal resident of Collier County, Florida.
- am not a citizen of the United States.
- am a convicted felon and my civil rights have not been restored.
- am under prosecution for a crime.
- am an expectant mother and / or parent not employed full-time and who has custody of a child under 6 years of age.
- am a full-time caregiver responsible for the care of a person who because of physical/mental incapacity is incapable of caring for him/herself.
- am a full-time Law Enforcement officer.

IMPORTANT: ONCE SUMMONED, UNLESS THERE IS A STATUTORY EXEMPTION AS LISTED ABOVE, THE ONLY AUTHORITY WHO CAN EXCUSE YOU FROM JUROR DUTY IS THE JUDGE OF THE COURT TO WHICH YOU HAVE BEEN SUMMONED. IF FURTHER INFORMATION IS REQUIRED, PLEASE CALL THE JURY CLERK AT (239)252-2646 OR (239)252-8335.
